
western Sicily is currently putting the finishing touch to its third Admiral 250 hydrofoil, *Carmen M.* The first of the 32m design, *Carlo Morace*, entered service with Ustica Lines, now known as Liberty Lines, in 2014. A second, *Ammari'*, was launched the following year. In addition, the first of the considerably larger 38m Admiral 350, *Gianni M*, was launched at the Trapani

shipyard in March 2016 and following extensive tests entered service with Liberty Lines earlier this year.

The official launch date of $Carmen\ M$ has yet to be set but is expected to happen fairly soon.

Since late June *Ammari'* is allocated to a new, seasonal international route between Otranto on Italy's Adriatic coast and Greece.
